CHOW: Pet Food Assistance

Those who are on government assistance of any kind are qualified to receive pet food assistance through the Humane Society for Southwest Washington's CHOW program. Families receive one month's supply of food, per household, per month. Animals are required to be spayed or neutered, and owners must agree to not acquire new pets while using the program.
